

## EXPOSING THE REAL REASON THE NORTH INVADED THE SOUTH

Back in the 1830's, South Carolina gave the real reason they wanted to secede, which was 'The Tariff of Abominations'.

To which President Jackson threatened to hang all the secessionists, including his own former vice-President, John C. Calhoun. Obviously, no Southern State would ever use that reason again as a reason for secession. The South never fought for slavery and the North didn't invade over Slavery.

The North made every effort to give the South slavery FOREVER.

In 1860 and 1861, the Northern Financial Powers made a headlong rush to grant the South Permanent Constitutionally protected slavery forever, as long as the South paid the new huge Tariff which in turn fed the robber-barons of the North via Federal subsidies. The "Corwin Amendment" would have Constitutionally protected slavery FOREVER in ANY State where slavery was legal, which includes any and all future States that voted to legalize slavery in their State. Also, the 'Corwin Amendment' was worded in such a way that it couldn't be undone with another Constitutional amendment.

Representative Thomas Corwin of Ohio introduced it in the House of Representatives in December 1860, and Senator William H. Seward of New York ( who personally was against slavery) introduced the 'Corwin' amendment in the Senate also in December 1860. Senator Seward's actions fully display the hidden hand of the financial elite of the north-east.

The predatory financial oligarchs of the north-east could care less about slavery, as long as the South paid the tariff increase that fed the subsidies going to Northern industries.

This squarely places ALL blame for the WAR on the Financial Oligarchs of the North.

The 'failure' of the 'Corwin' Amendment, which would have forever Constitutionally protected slavery, to entice the South back into the Union, is absolute, irrefutable proof that the Northern invasion had nothing to do with slavery. When some Southern States SAID they seceded because of slavery that was a pretense. Back in 1828, when South Carolina almost seceded, they bluntly stated the REAL reason, that It was the "Tariff of Abominations", which then resulted in an IMMEDIATE Federal forceful reaction.

UNION meant that the tariff revenue from the South would still flow into the Federal coffers and back to the North.

UNION also meant that the Northern manufacturers wouldn't lose most of the domestic market they had in the South, since if the CSA was established the South would have had a free trade zone with low tariffs and they would have bought better quality goods from the UK at a lower price than the Northern manufacturers could offer. The MONEY powers would do anything to get the South back in the Union and retain the revenue stream arrangement of tariffs paid by the South.
